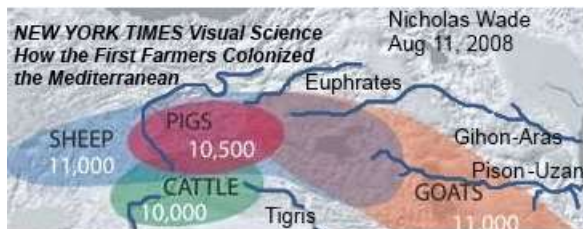


Eden and Babel

- Gen 2:8 And the LORD God planted a garden in Eden, in the east, and there he put the man whom he had formed.
- Gen 2:9 And out of the ground the LORD God made to spring up every tree that is pleasant to the sight and good for food. The tree of life was in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.
- Gen 2:10 A river flowed out of Eden to water the garden, and there spread out and existed four rivers.
- Gen 2:11 The name of the first is the Pishon. It is the one that flowed around the whole land of Havilah, where there is gold.
- Gen 2:12 And the gold of that land is good; bdellium and onyx stone are there.
- Gen 2:13 The name of the second river is the Gihon (Aras/Araxes). It is the one that flowed around the whole land of Cush.
- Gen 2:14 And the name of the third river is the Tigris, which flows east of Assyria. And the fourth river is the Euphrates. (ESV)



The domestication of animals and agricultural crops centers around and branches out from the area of Eden as specified in Genesis 2:10-14. Crop farming and animal farming developed simultaneously as per Genesis 4:2

Rivers enhanced and names added July 2022

- Gen 11:1 Now the whole land had one language and the same words.
- Gen 11:2 And as people migrated from the east, they found a plain in the land of Shinar and settled there.
- Gen 11:3 And they said to one another, "Come, let us make bricks, and burn them thoroughly." And they had brick for stone, and bitumen for mortar.
- Gen 11:4 Then they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city and a tower with its top in the heavens, and let us make a name for ourselves, lest we be dispersed over the face of the whole land."
- Gen 11:5 And the LORD came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of man had built.
- Gen 11:6 And the LORD said, "Behold, they are one people, and they have all one language, and this is only the beginning of what they will do. And nothing that they propose to do will now be impossible for them.
- Gen 11:7 Come, let us go down and there confuse their language, so that they may not understand one another's speech."
- Gen 11:8 So the LORD dispersed them from there over the face of all the land, and they left off building the city.

Gen 11:9 Therefore its name was called Babel, because there the LORD confused the language of all the land. And from there the LORD dispersed them over the face of all the land. (ESV)
